

Ranking Cities in America

You and your partner will be picking four cities from a random list of cities. You are going to use the site www.bestplaces.net to gather the following information about each of the cities:

Population

Median Income

Median Age

Average rainfall per year

Average number of sunny days per year

Median Home Cost

Unemployment Rate

Money spent per student in the school system

Set up a Google Sheet to organize your data and show comparisons between the four different cities. After analyzing all of the data, you want to rank the 4 cities in order from most desirable to live in to least desirable. You must use your data to argue your case. You can use charts, do ranking orders, anything you want to help make your case for your decision.

To get your four random cities, go to <https://perchance.org/us-city> and where it asks “how many?” type in 4 and then hit the button to the left that says “randomize.” This will give you your four cities. If for some reason you can’t find the information on one of the cities from www.bestplaces.net, go back and pick one new city from <https://perchance.org/us-city>
